The Division of Pensions has yet to release specific information outlining the exact impact of the recently adopted legislative changes governing pension loan procedures due to take effect effective January 1, 2008.

Emergency Medical Services System Review:

The New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services is taking comment and input from interested parties with regard to the recently issued independent review of New Jersey's emergency medical services delivery system.
